

NORTH MIDDLETON TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

October 11, 2016

The North Middleton Township Board of Supervisors held a budget workshop meeting on Tuesday, October 11, 2016 at the North Middleton Township Municipal Building, 2051 Spring Road, Carlisle PA. The meeting was called to order by Chairman James Hare at 5:30 PM. Board members present were: Supervisor Bob Reisinger, Supervisor Harry Kelso, Supervisor Pat McDowell and Manager Deborah A. Ealer. Supervisor Dave Smith was not in attendance. There were no visitors.

The Board reviewed the proposed meeting dates for 2017. It will be placed on the workshop agenda for approval.

The Board will leave the Sunoco easement in the general fund to offset the 2016 deficit.

General Fund expenses were discussed. Pat asked that a new line item for temporary emergency housing be added to the Emergency Budget. These funds would only be used in case of an emergency for North Middleton residents. It would cover the cost of families needing to evacuate their home to a hotel temporarily.

Donation requests submitted by the Bosler Library and the LeTort Authority for a scholarship were not approved.

The Board discussed assisting in fund raising for the Carlisle fireworks.

Bob Reisinger motioned to hire HRG to complete North Middleton Township's MS4 application to DEP, Harry Kelso seconded, with 4 yeas, motion carried.

The Board will reconsider the police audit during the 2018 budget.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:20 pm.
