

North Middleton Township Board of Supervisors June 1, 2017

The meeting of the North Middleton Township Board of Supervisors was held at the Township Municipal Building, 2051 Spring Road, Carlisle PA on June 1, 2017. Chairman Robert Reisinger called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Board members present were Vice Chairman Harry Kelso, Supervisor James Hare, Supervisor Pat McDowell, Police Chief Gary Carver and Recording Secretary Lori Coleman. Supervisor David Smith, Solicitor Mark Allshouse, and Manager Deborah Ealer were not in attendance

No public comment was offered.

No plans were presented.

North Middleton Authority

a. May Manager Report

Supervisor Reisinger presented the May Manager's report from Lee Koch.

b. April Minutes

Supervisor Reisinger presented the April minutes. Due to the recent responses from the survey, NMA is not pursuing the water extension on Longs Gaps Road. Supervisor Hare asked if the survey would be published. Supervisor Reisinger noted it would be posted on the website. Supervisor Kelso asked if a residence had to connect. Supervisor Reisinger referenced a mandatory connection ordinance that if a structure is within 150ft of a water line then they must connect.

Solicitor

a. May Report

Supervisor Reisinger said Solicitor Allshouse's monthly report was circulated to the board. No questions were presented.

Supervisor Hare moved to approve the consent agenda items a through c with the recommended corrections and Supervisor McDowell seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Township Manager

Police Chief

a. May Report

Chief Carver noted the department received notification from the state that all officers were recertified for another two years. The officers have met all their mandatory obligations for training and in-service training.

Engineers Report

No report presented.

New Business

No items were discussed.

Old Business

a. Spring and Cavalry Road Intersection- James Hare

Supervisor Hare noted conversations with Brian Glass, a supervisor at PennDOT for NMT concerning the intersection. He indicated to him that it would be a long time before PennDOT is able to completely revamp the intersection. Supervisor Hare discussed a few options: a left turn lane both north and south bound, a left turn lane southbound on Rt. 34 without a signal, or a left turn signal on Rt. 34 south. Supervisor Hare mentioned the back-up of traffic in the mornings. Supervisor Hare inquired about the next step since the township has received a grant. Supervisor Reisinger noted the initial grant was to replace all the lights at the intersection. Then, the township reapplied for a grant due to the funding match which would also replace all the lights at the intersection. Supervisor Reisinger added the township has not received the funds yet. He suggested reaching out to PennDOT to see if the funding would permit a southbound left turn arrow light. Supervisor Hare noted he would contact Mr. Glass. Supervisor Kelso asked if an engineering study would be required. Chief Carver felt a traffic study would be required to justify the left turn arrow. As far as the grant, Supervisor Reisinger noted the previous engineer utilized is no longer available. When the township receives the grant, they will need to select a new traffic engineer.

Executive Session

An executive session would be held following the meeting to discuss a personnel issue. No vote would be taken.

Adjournment

Supervisor Hare moved to adjourn the meeting at 6:12 p.m. Supervisor McDowell seconded the motion, and the motion carried.
