ORDINANCE NO. 2015-02

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH MIDDLETON
AMENDING, CHANGING AND MODIFYING REGULATIONS FOR PARK
AND RECREATIONAL FACILITIES, SECTION 140-4(J) OF THE CODE OF
ORDINANCES OF NORTH MIDDLETON TOWNSHIP ENTITLED
PROHIBITED ACTS

The Board of Supervisors of North Middleton Township hereby ordains as follows:

Section 1. Amendment.

Section 140-4 (J) of the Code of Ordinances of North Middleton Township shall be amended and modified as follows:

J. No person shall possess a firearm of any type except in conformance with federal, state and local laws, including the transport or carrying thereof. In addition, bows, arrows, airguns, slingshots and fireworks or any other lethal weapon not already regulated by federal or state law shall, likewise, be illegal to possess.

Section 2. Continuation.

All other provisions of the Code and its underlying Ordinances, so far as they are the same as those Ordinances in force immediately prior to the enactment of this Ordinance, are intended as a continuation of such Ordinances and not as new enactments. Provisions of this Ordinance shall not affect any act done or liability incurred, nor shall they affect any suit or pro-section pending or to be instituted to enforce any right or penalty or to punish any offense under the authority of any Ordinance repealed by this Ordinance.

Section 3. Effective Date.

This Ordinance shall become effective by operation of law pursuant to the Second Class Township Code of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

Section 4. Severability.


In the event that any provision, section, sentence, clause or part of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid, such invalidity shall not affect or impair any remaining provisions, section, sentence, clause or part of this Ordinance or other Ordinances affected by this Ordinance, it being the intent of North Middleton Township that such remainder shall be and shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 5. Relationship to Other Ordinances.

All other Ordinances, parts of Ordinances or parts of Resolutions inconsistent herewith shall be and the same are expressly repealed.



The Board of Supervisors of North Middleton Township will hold a hearing to take public comment on proposed Ordinance No. 2015-02 entitled AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH MIDDLETON AMENDING, CHANGING AND MODIFYING REGULATIONS FOR PARK AND RECREATIONAL FACILITIES, SECTION 140-4(J) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF NORTH MIDDLETON TOWNSHIP ENTITLED PROHIBITED ACTS, during their regularly scheduled Board of Supervisors meeting at 6:30 p.m. on Thursday, March 5, 2015, or any other time which the public hearing may be continued by the Board of Supervisors, at the North Middleton Township Municipal Building, 2051 Spring Road, Carlisle, Pennsylvania 17013.
