

NORTH MIDDLETON TOWNSHIP

REGULATIONS FOR USE OF TOWNSHIP PARKS
PARK HOURS – 8:00 AM TO DUSK

ALL TRASH MUST BE DEPOSITED IN DUMPSTERS PROVIDED

The following acts and conduct are prohibited in North Middleton Parks:

1. Possession or use of alcoholic beverages.
2. Boisterous, immoral, indecent, or obscene conduct.
3. Discarding of trash, garbage, or other litter, except into the trash dumpster(s)/recycling containers provided in the vicinity of the pavilions.
4. Damaging, defacing, destroying, or removing any township owned property, sign, structure, equipment, or other material; driving nails or other hardware into trees.
5. Posting of signs; distributing, selling, servicing, or renting of any supplies, equipment, material, or commodity whatsoever, or soliciting for any purpose, without written authorization from the township supervisors.
6. Operating, stopping, or parking of any vehicle or bicycle, except on designated roads, trails, or areas.
7. Operating any vehicle or bicycle in a reckless or negligent manner, in excess of posted speed limit of 10 mph, or in such a manner as to become a nuisance to other users.
8. All recreational vehicles including, but not necessarily being limited to the following: motorcycles; motorbikes; all-terrain vehicles; motor-driven cycles; motor-scooters; motorized pedacycles; 3-wheelers; snowmobiles; and any other like or similar form of motorized propulsion, as well as any motor vehicle, whether or not same is required to be licensed by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
9. Commercial vehicular traffic, unless providing authorized service.
10. Possession, except in transit on self or in vehicle or bicycle operated or owned by person, or discharge of any type of firearms, bows and arrows, air guns, slingshots, or fireworks, or lethal or dangerous weapons.

Regulations for use of Township Parks cont'd.

- 11. Hunting, trapping, and training of dogs.**
- 12. Camping, picnicking, swimming, boat launching, or mooring, and use of all fires, except in designated areas and facilities. No fires will be left untended nor charcoal deposited or discarded.**
- 13. Any form of recreation or activity, except in designated areas established by the recreation board.**
- 14. Leashed dogs are permitted in North Middleton, Creekview and Village Parks, with the understanding all waste is removed by person in charge of dog(s) in any park. Any other animals and/or pets, whatever nature or type are not permitted in any parks.**
- 15. Swimming, except where authorized by the Pennsylvania Department of Health or any other appropriate state agency.**

PENALTY FOR VIOLATION: Any person violating any of these prohibitions shall be liable, upon summary conviction, to a fine of not less than two hundred dollars (\$200) nor more than six hundred dollars (\$600), together with the costs of prosecution in each case.

By allowing you to use the Recreational Facilities of North Middleton Township, you are agreeing to pay, protect, indemnify and save harmless North Middleton Township from and against any and all liabilities, damages, costs, expenses, fees, including attorney's fees, cause of action, suits, claims, demands or judgments of any kind or nature in connection with personal injury or the loss of life and/or damage to personal property arising from or out of your use of any North Middleton Township Recreational Facility as a result of any breach of any covenant or condition, or occasioned wholly or in part by any act, omission, carelessness, negligence or other improper conduct on your part or on the part of others in or about the Recreational Facility or any part thereof.
