July 26, 2015

The Recreation Advisory Board meeting was held at North Middleton Township Park, 1701 Waggoners Gap Road, Carlisle, PA 17013 on July 26, 2015. Chairman David Hoover called the meeting to order at 3:30 p.m. Board members present were Chair David Hoover, Laurie Hoover, Jeff Brenizer and Recreation Director Annette McKillip.

**Visitors:** None

Following the Pledge of Allegiance, the Minutes of the June 23, 2015 Recreation Advisory Board meeting were approved on motion of Jeff Brenizer, seconded by Laurie Hoover. Motion carried unanimously.

**Directors Report:**

- A. **Administrative Assistant/Recreation Director:** Interviews have been conducted.
- B. **Budget:** Second quarter budget was reviewed
- C. **Budget 2016:** A price quote from Hilton's Lock & Security Services was requested to look at installing security cameras in the parks. The budget this year was moved up from September to August.
- D. **Pavilion Rentals:** Rentals on July 23<sup>rd</sup> were one hundred thirty-eight, totaling \$5,660 with 8,335 guests. There was no meeting in June 2014 to compare it to.
- E. **Summertime Adventure:** Cindy Bear turned in a breakdown of this year's program. She does such a wonderful job.

**New Business:**

- A. **Car Show:** A few people at the car show gave a monetary donation. It was discussed for next year to advertise on our flyer that we would accept donations to reduce the costs of the car show or the children's programs.
- B. **Vandalism:** Vandals had spray painted the inside of the men's room on the walls and inside the toilet stall at Creekview Park. The police department has made a report of the incident. There was also a "rowdy" group that rented Village Park on Sat. July 4<sup>th</sup>. One of the park's employees had to spend extra time cleaning up after them. He also noticed there was alcohol present and they had moved tables around and had vehicles driving in the park during the day. A verbal complaint was received from a resident in the area about the volume of music that was playing and the police department did respond. The person who rented these pavilions will not be allowed to reserve any pavilions in any of your parks anymore.

**Old Business:**

- A. **Carlisle Area Little League:** The team has requested for a three year agreement. The recommendation was to have the team put their request in letter form to the Recreation Advisory Board and also include the monetary value of what has been done and what they are proposing to do. The price of the renovations to the back stop are proposed to be three to five thousand and work was already approved previous and will begin in August. Fall ball will begin in August and run to the end of October.
